Everyone is aware of the devastating fires in northern Alberta this past spring. What everyone may not be aware of is the disastrous impact that the fires have had on Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation. In this community of approximately 1,600 people, all community members had to be evacuated to other nearby communities and many had to use their personal resources for lodging, clothing, food and basic necessities. Upon the staged re-entry return 25 days later, the community came home to find 45 buildings burned down, including 38 residences. The destroyed residences were home to 150 community members, as documented in the records of Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation ("Impacted Community Members") many of which are elders and children.

The loss of these homes, all their contents and personal belongings has been heartbreaking for the community. Kiwetinohk Energy Corp. ("Kiwetinohk") and Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation ("Sturgeon Lake") are working together as neighbors to help those who have lost their homes get back on their feet. We need your help - the help of the much larger community of other industrial developers, concerned local businesses and individual Albertans to give a much-needed boost to those who have lost their homes.

To that end, Kiwetinohk and its employees will be organizing a fundraising golf tournament for the benefit of the Impacted Community Members. Kiwetinohk is also looking for co-sponsors for this tournament. All funds generated by the tournament - through co-sponsorships, silent auctions and other means in excess of the cost (i.e. any "profit") - will be solely for the benefit of the Impacted Community Members, which will be disbursed by the Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation in an appropriate and equitable manner. All funds raised will be held by Kiwetinohk in a separate bank account and all accounting records (including the disbursement of the funds) will be made available to any interested contributors upon request.

1) Where do we send our cheque and who do I write my cheque out to?

5) How is Kiwetinohk managing the money?

A separate bank account has been set up for golf tournament funds. A cheque will be written to Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation with the proceeds from the golf tournament.

6) Can we get a schedule of receipts and disbursements showing cash in/out?

Yes, a donation list and expense summary statement will be provided to all major donors.

7) Will I receive a donation receipt?

Kiwetinohk and Sturgeon Lake are not registered charities and will not be able to provide a donation receipt. Sponsorship fees may be an eligible business expense so please consult with your accounting team or tax advisor.

Silent auction item donations for the reasons above can not receive a donation receipt but may be eligible as a business expense.

Golf Tournament:

8) Where do we send list of golfers attending to represent our company (see sponsorship opportunities list for number of golfers eligible per type of sponsorship)?

Either enclose the list with your cheque or one of the Kiwetinohk golf committee members will contact you for your golfer list.

9) What is the tournament format?

Texas scramble shotgun start at 1:00pm. 18 holes.

Texas scramble – Each player tees off and then as a group you decide which of the shots you should use. Once you've decided which tee shot to take, all players retrieve their balls and take the second shot from the agreed position. This format continues until the ball is in the hole. As a result, only one score is recorded for a team on each hole. The "texas' part is that you must use three drives from each player throughout the round. Shotgun start – all players start from their designated hole at 1:00pm when the horn goes off. The course reps will lead golfers out to their designated hole so it's important to be ready and in your cart by 12:40pm. Designated hole information will be provided at registration.

10) Will there be prizes?

Yes, there will be pro shop gift cards for hole and team prizes.

11) What happens if we get rained out will it be rescheduled?

Please prepare for the golf tournament to go on as planned and dress for the weather. Only in extreme weather will the tournament be canceled. In the unlikely event the tournament is canceled, all registration fees will be treated as a donation, no refunds will be provided and there will not be a makeup date for the event.

12) How many teams will be allowed?

There is a maximum number of 54 teams and registration is reserved for sponsors at this time.

13) Will there be golf cart available for golfers?

Golf carts will be provided for all golfers.

14) Will there be transportation provided to the golf course?

Everyone is responsible for their own transportation to and from the golf course. Do not drink and drive.
